

Montagne gets state pact

MANCHESTER — Montagne Communications LLC has won a two-year contract worth \$200,000 to provide public relations services to the state Division of Travel and Tourism Development.

The Executive Council approved the contract yesterday. The city-based firm will work mostly on public relations work, while also working on new media

and social media-based campaigns. The end goal is to boost the number of tourists who visit New Hampshire.

"We're ecstatic. From what I understand, there was a good-sized group of really qualified firms (who bid for the work). We're honored and pleased to work with the state of New Hampshire," said Scott Tranchemontagne, the company's presi-

dent.

The company has done work for the state before, including the New Hampshire Lottery Commission and the state liquor commission. Montagne's client roster includes FairPoint Communications, Citizens Bank New Hampshire, Waste Management and Chelsea Property Group.

The firm recently celebrated its one-year anniversary.
